Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat is one of the top producers in Burgundy and traces its origin back to the early '60s. Founded by Alain Hudelot, he ran the estate for 45 years. In 1978, he married Odile Noëllat (granddaughter of Charles Noëllat), this union brought new vineyards under the domaine.

In 2008, Alain Hudelot handed over the reins of the winemaking and management of Domaine Hudelot-Noëllat to his grandson, **Charles van Canneyt**. By this time, Charles had completed his wine studies at Dijon University. When he took over, he chose to respect his grandfather's vision which was always to let the *terroir* express itself in the wines. Charles instituted a program of evolution at the domaine rather than revolution.

As a rising star in Burgundy whose fame and demand for his wines combined with an interest in doing his own project led Charles to create a négociant business under his own name in 2012. He described this new project as follows: *"They're two completely different things. At the domaine, it's family, I work for my grandparents. This is something for me."* When Charles began this project he produced only a few barrels that were sourced from top vineyards (mainly *grands crus* vineyards). The market responded favourably to the wines. The style is precise with good fruit and finesse, and each plot is distinguishable when tasted side by side.
